

**AUGUST 20, 2011  
SPECIAL ELECTION**

**PROPOSED SANDY CREEK WATER DISTRICT**

**RULES OF VOTING**

- 1) The special election for the proposed Sandy Creek Water District in the Town of Sandy Creek shall occur at the Town Hall on August 20, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- 2) All owners of taxable real property located within the proposed water district as shown on the 2011 assessment roll are entitled to vote in this election.
- 3) Every joint tenant, tenant in common, or other person with a direct ownership of taxable real property located within the proposed water district is entitled to vote.
- 4) A corporation or partnership owning taxable real property located within the proposed water district is entitled to one (1) vote each. The person voting on behalf of the corporation or partnership must present a copy of the corporate or partnership resolution authorizing said person to vote on behalf of the entity.
- 5) When the owner listed on the 2011 assessment roll has passed away or property is listed as being owned by an estate, an estate representative may vote. The representative of the estate must present a copy of Letters issued by a Surrogate Court.

- 6) A trust owning taxable real property within the proposed district is entitled to one (1) vote. A representative of the trust must present a copy of the Trust Agreement.
- 7) Regardless of the number of parcels owned by a land owner, each land owner is entitled to one (1) vote only.
- 8) All votes must be cast in person and no absentee ballots will be allowed.
- 9) No votes may be made by a Power of Attorney or agent except as provided for corporations, partnerships, estates and trusts. Each eligible voter must provide valid identification to the Election Inspectors.
- 10) All votes shall be cast by ballot after eligible voters have signed the voter book.
- 11) After presenting valid proof of identification, signing the voter book, a voter may proceed to the voting booth.
- 12) The Town shall provide a voting booth for voters to cast their vote.
- 13) At the close of the election, the votes shall be tallied.
